MORNING WORSHIP

Our morning service meets every week at 10:30 a.m.

As the main gathering point for Shiloh, our

morning worship includes elements that will be meaningful for all age groups. The service is Presbyterian in its structure and flexible in its styles of music.

A typical Sunday morning will include an Organ Prelude or Praise Music, Announcements, Responsive Call to Worship, Hymn, Invocation, Prayer of Confession, Offertory, Special Music, Children's Message, Anthem, Scripture Reading, Sermon, Hymn, Pastoral Prayer, Benediction and a closing Postlude. It is not unusual to have orchestras, a cello, flute, piano, guitar, saxophone, singing groups, a children's choir, praise bands, and a bell choir as part of the service.

The Sacrament of the Lord's Supper is observed on the first Sunday of every month.

There is a supervised room for young children to go to after the Children's message. The Sanctuary has a hard of hearing system and also an alcove that is handicapped accessible.

Everyone is welcome to join us as we worship with grand tradition blended with a modern flare.
